# Ways to Pray

For so many people in the world who remain unreached by the gospel, both near and far, we pray for the harvest. We pray for workers to go, for movements of multiplication to ignite the church where it doesn't yet exist, to express worship and community in faithful and culturally meaningful ways. As the global church, we join in prayer that God would open eyes to his salvation and raise up workers to bring his good news!

### Ways to pray for gospel-unreached people:

- **Church planting movements**  
Pray for movements to faith in Jesus among unreached communities, for millions to be baptized and discipled. (Matthew 28:19)
- **The witness of local believers**  
Pray for the believers among the unreached to be enthusiastic witnesses, sharing their faith in Christ with their community in a meaningful way. (1 Peter 3:15)
- **The proximate church to have a heart and ministry of reconciliation**  
Pray for those churches with a near language, culture, or geography to have a burden and intentionally plant churches among their neighbors. (2 Corinthians 5:18–20)
- **Collaborative efforts in the global church to reach the world**  
Pray for unity and partnerships, and that the global church can work together to devote greater efforts towards unreached places and people groups.
- **Scriptures in all languages**  
Pray for written and oral translations of the scriptures to be made available to people groups who do not have a Bible in their language. (1 Corinthians 14:10–11)
